The Wyoming Community College Commission is now accepting proposals for Adult Education (AE) programs under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Title II. These programs include AE, Corrections Education and Education of Other Institutionalized Individuals, and Integrated English Literacy and Civics Education. AE programs assist adults in becoming literate, obtaining knowledge and skills necessary for employment and self-sufficiency, becoming partners in their children's education and completing their Wyoming High School Equivalency certificate. This is a three (3) year grant cycle. The performance period begins July 1, 2017, and ends June 30, 2020. The grant is renewable for the second and third year based on performance.
