LOOKING FOR COVID-19 ANSWERS?



Wyoming 2-1-1 and the Wyoming Department of Health (WDH) are partnering to provide a public telephone helpline for COVID-19 questions and information.



WHAT IS WYOMING 211?

Wyoming 2-1-1 is a statewide helpline which provides free, confidential information and referrals to health and human services. By dialing 2-1-1 from anywhere in the state of Wyoming, people are linked to information about COVID-19 as well as local resources, from both government and nonprofit agencies.



WHEN CAN I CALL?

2-1-1 is available Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m.to 6:00 p.m. Callers requesting information outside standard business hours may leave a voicemail message and will receive a follow-up call the next business day.



WHAT IS THE NUMBER?

Service is available statewide by dialing **2-1-1 or 888-425-7138** during normal business hours. Wyoming 2-1-1 also connects callers to other health and human services in their community. Many of these resources may also be needed by Wyoming residents at this time.
