PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS:

The types of articulation agreements vary between colleges and generally fall within three categories:

1. General Ed Block Agreements indicate the transfer institution will accept a graduate's AA or AS degree as meeting their general education requirements for any bachelor's degree.
2. Course-to-course agreements indicate a transfer institution's precedence for accepting certain courses as they relate to transferring into specific degree programs at the partner institution.
3. Degree specific articulations indicate a detailed transfer pathway for specific degrees at the partner institution, unlike block agreements which work for any bachelor's degree.

COST:

The colleges incur minimal costs, if any, in establishing articulation agreements with their partners.

HEADCOUNT:

The number of students, whether measured in terms of headcount or FTE, which may ultimately transfer to an institution with an articulation agreement can't accurately be estimated in advance. However, credits awarded to these students via community college instruction, and prior to transfer to another institution, are included in total enrollment used to determine college FTEs and headcounts. In contrast, credits awarded to students by other institutions, despite the fact that the instruction may have occurred on a Wyoming community college campus, are not included in total enrollment used to determine college FTEs and headcounts. Credit hours delivered can only be claimed by the awarding institution.
